

Club Charter

Volleyball ACT (VACT) encourages clubs to become affiliated with the Association.

Clubs are encouraged to join VACT in the promotion of the sport while displaying the characteristics of the *Essence of Australian Sport* – Fairness, Respect, Responsibility and Safety (http://www.ausport.gov.au/about/essence of sport)

Application to become a VACT Affiliated Club must be made to the General Manager of VACT and be approved by the VACT board.

To be eligible for affiliation with VACT, a club must meet at least the following minimum requirements:-

- Be an incorporated body
- Have a functioning committee with at least a President, Secretary and Treasurer
- Have a constitution that specifically ties the club to VACT
- Meet minimum club activity requirements as set out by VACT from time to time

Affiliated Clubs are an integral part of the VACT organisation. As such they have obligations, including but not limited to:-

- Register all members with VACT
- Abide by and support all VACT Corporate Documents, Plans and Policies
 E.g. Constitution, Strategic Plan, Code of Conduct etc
- Meet all financial obligations to VACT
- Submit an annual report on club activities to be included in the VACT Annual Report

VACT affiliated clubs will be:-

- Eligible to participate in the full range of VACT competitions and programs
- Covered by the VACT Public Liability Insurance policy for all official club trainings and events
